Angelos Pangratis served as the senior career official in the United States for the EU for the past four years. He was the Chargée D’Affaires of the Delegation from Oct. 2009 to July 2010. Dr. Pangratis is a former Ambassador and Head of Delegation for the European Commission’s Delegation to Argentina (2003-05), and fulfilled senior functions in the Delegations of the European Commission in South Africa (1995-1997) and South Korea (1990-1994). He also worked at the EU’s headquarters in Brussels, Belgium in several Head of Unit and Head of Investigation capacities and represented the European Commission at numerous Multilateral Organizations including the WTO, OECD, Club de Paris, and UNCTAD. Born on the Greek island of Corfu, Dr. Pangratis speaks Greek, French, English, and Spanish. He earned his doctorate from the University of Paris I, Panthéon Sorbonne in International Economics, Monetary Policies and Finance.

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
